

## **Admission Standards for Mid-Coast School of Technology**

1. Priority for admission is given to students from the Region 8 sending high schools based on available number of slots for each school as designated by the Student Services Coordinator.
2. Slots that are not filled by May 15th through the Student Services Coordinator will become available to other sending school students for enrollment into MCST programs.
3. Homeschooled high school students can be enrolled in any program provided there are available slots not taken by sending schools and they meet the same grade level and pre-requisite requirements for Region 8 sending schools.
4. Lincoln Academy High School students can be enrolled on a tuition basis into MCST programs provided there are available slots after enrolling sending school students and homeschooled students from Region 8 districts.
5. Post-grad students who have been enrolled in a MCST program as an undergrad will be considered for enrollment in the year immediately following graduation provided he/she is age 19 or under at the beginning of the school year, is recommended by their undergrad instructor, and slots are available in the program after enrollment of all Region 8 sending school students, homeschooled students, and Lincoln Academy tuition students.
6. All students must meet the minimum grade level and pre-requisite requirements found in the MCST program guidelines.
7. Persons 20 years of age or older residing in the communities served by MCST may enroll in a CTE program provided the placement does not prevent the enrollment of secondary or post-grad students described in items 1-6 above. An appropriate tuition to be determined by the director will be charged. Prior to admission, prospective students must complete a satisfactory background check.
