ADF SCHOOL COMMITMENT TO LEARNING RESULTS

The Region 8 Cooperative Board hereby adopts the system of learning results and the Maine Department of Education’s applicable rules. The learning results system is intended to serve as a foundation for education reform and to provide assessment of student learning, accountability and equitable opportunities for all students to access the content standards. The Cooperative Board recognizes that the legislative intent of the learning results system is to provide children with schools that reflect high expectations and create conditions where these expectations can be met.

The Cooperative Board understands that implementation of the learning results system has broad implications for the school, including curriculum, budget, professional development, student assessment, professional evaluation, and graduation requirements. Therefore, the Board is committed to examining its policies to make them consistent with the intent and goals of the learning results system.

The Cooperative Board directs the Director to develop a plan and timeline for implementing the learning results system and any appropriate administrative procedures. The Board further directs the Director to report to the Board annually by May 1st on progress toward implementing the learning results system.
