IHDC Adults Attending Day Programs

The philosophy of Region 8 provides for the entry level training, upgrading, or re-training for employment. In this effort the Cooperative Board may allow persons 20 years of age or older to enroll in the regular day programs in accordance with published admission standards and Maine statutes, provided:

1. The enrollment of adults does not displace or prevent enrollment of secondary school students.
2. The adult applicants have the approval of the Director prior to enrollment in regular day programs.
3. The enrollment is full-time in the program.
4. The adult adheres to all rules and regulations (except transportation to and from the program) applying to regular day students.
5. Appropriate fee to be determined by the Director.
6. All costs of materials for personal projects, uniforms, safety gear, and other items of a personal nature required for the program are borne by the adult enrollee.
7. The adult must reside within the communities served by Region 8.
8. The enrollment of adults complies with State of Maine statutes. Other requests for adult enrollment will be reviewed by the Cooperative Board and the Director.
