



Dear Students, Parents and Guardians,

This letter is to inform you that a person associated with Mid-Coast School of Technology and Camden Hills Regional High School has tested positive for COVID-19. Ten individuals have been identified as close contacts at Mid-Coast and will be quarantining for 10 days from the last point of contact. Other individuals identified as close contacts at Camden Hills will be notified by a CHRHS staff member.

Throughout this process, Mid-Coast will continue to follow the Maine CDC recommendations and guidelines. Because of the precautions in place and the structure of our programs, the direct impact on our student body is very small. All identified areas of the school will be cleaned and sanitized before students arrive for classes on Wednesday morning.

To ensure student and staff safety, we ask that you continue to complete the pre-screening checklist before coming to school. If COVID-19 symptoms do arise, we ask you to immediately call your healthcare provider for further guidance.

We ask that you and your student honor the privacy of the people directly affected by this virus and continue to do your part to stay safe and healthy.
